Thank you for requesting the comments of the Division for Historic Preservation of the Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation (OPRHP). We have reviewed the submitted materials in accordance with the New York State Historic Preservation Act of 1980 (section 14.09 of the New York Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation Law). These comments are those of the Division for Historic Preservation and relate only to Historic/Cultural resources. They do not include potential environmental impacts to New York State Parkland that may be involved in or near your project. Such impacts must be considered as part of the environmental review of the project pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act (New York Environmental Conservation Law Article 8) and its implementing regulations (6NYCRR Part 617).

We note the Area of Potential Effect (APE) includes the Glen Historic District and the New York State Barge Canal Historic District both of which are listed in the State and National Registers of Historic Places (S/NRHP). Additionally, there are numerous S/NRHP listed, and eligible for listing, historic resources within the APE. We have reviewed the Site Plan dated October 8, 2020, and the Historic Resource Survey dated January 2022. Based on our review, it is the OPRHP's opinion the project, as described, will have No Adverse Impact on historic or cultural resources as the wind turbines are not visible from the majority of the historic resources.
